This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioners from carrying on their business activities as licensed street vendors under the provisions of The Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014 and Rules and Scheme framed thereunder with further prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation dated 10.01.2020 to Station House Officer, Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana and representations dated 28.01.2020 and 15.02.2020 to Principal Secretary, Department of Home Affairs, Civil Secretariat, Punjab, Chandigarh and Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, copies of which are available on the file as Annexure P/3 (Colly), but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to Station House Officer, Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana, Principal Secretary, Department of Home Affairs, Civil Secretariat, Punjab, Chandigarh and Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into and decide representations dated 10.01.2020, 28.01.2020 and 15.02.2020 (Annexure P/3-Colly), as expeditiously as possible and that too in accordance with law.
