MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner-Sunil has filed this petition for grant of interim bail for 30 days in case FIR No.495 dated 03.08.2017, under Sections 302, 34, 120-B IPC and 25 Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, Hodal, District Palwal to enable him to attend the marriage of his sister, namely, Seema, which is scheduled for 11.03.2020.

On 05.03.2020, learned State counsel was directed to verify the factum of marriage of sister of the petitioner. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Yashpal Singh, submits that the ground raised by the petitioner in the petition is not disputed as he being the only brother of his sister is to make arrangements for marriage, scheduled to take place on 11.03.2020.

After considering the prayer made by learned counsel for the

petitioner and the stand of learned State counsel, this Court does not find any reason to decline the prayer. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on interim bail w.e.f. 06.03.2020 to 16.03.2020 subject to his furnishing the requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the concerned Jail Authorities on 16.03.2020 before 05.00 P.M.

The petition is allowed.
