Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 2 dated 05.01.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 307 IPC was added later on, at Police Station Division No. 8, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case because of criminal litigation since long with family of the complainant. The injury attributed to petitioner is simple in nature, neither there was any MLR and nor any police report.

As per the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith other co-accused has entered into the house of the complainant and caused injuries.

Since, the petitioner was armed with kirpan and inflicted injury on the head of the complainant, therefore, this Court does not find any ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed.
