Reply on behalf of the respondent-State filed in Court, taken on record.

Prayer in this application is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in the light of the illness of his wife who is not only suffering from Diarrhea with UTI (Urinary Tract Infection) but is also a patient of acute renal failure. The father of the petitioner is 70 years of age and his mother is 65 years old. As per the stand of the State, his elder son is studying in class 12th and his younger son is studying in 7th class. The brother of the petitioner is also involved in a criminal case and is in custody. There is none in the family who can really take care of the wife of the petitioner.

These facts are admitted by the respondents in the reply which has been filed as per the directions of this Court.

Keeping in view the totality of the above-stated facts, the present application is allowed and the petitioner is granted interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar for a period of one week.

The petition stands disposed of.
