Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that both the petitioners are staying together and intend to perform marriage in future.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has also submitted that a representation dated 29.02.2020 was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (Annexure P3), seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of

marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P3) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.

This order shall not be construed to be conferring the legitimacy or authenticity to the factum of marriage, to be performed by the petitioners in future, as the Court is already deprived of any means to determine the aforesaid facts.

Disposed of accordingly.
