Sanjay Kumar, J. (Oral):

The grievance of the petitioner, the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat of Village Changali, Tehsil Dhuri, District Sangrur, Punjab, is that the authorities are not taking any action upon her legal notice dated 06.01.2020. By the said legal notice, she had sought action to be initiated against the Panches of the Gram Panchayat, who are arrayed as respondents No.5 to 9 in this writ petition.

However, perusal of the said legal notice demonstrates that it is completely bereft of details and does not even indicate as to what specific action the petitioner wanted the authorities to take. No details were furnished, which would be required as a condition precedent, for the authorities to initiate action under Section 20 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994.

Having made such a vague representation, it is not open to the petitioner to now complain of inaction on the part of the authorities. The writ petition is therefore utterly misconceived and is accordingly dismissed. This order shall however not preclude the petitioner from making a fresh representation with full and proper particulars, if she so chooses.

There shall be no order as to costs.
