Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.02 dated 14.01.2019 registered under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the bricks were thrown by the accused including the petitioner but it is an admitted fact that the brick, which hit deceased-Manjit Kaur was thrown by Harpreet Singh alias Lovely son of Mukhtiar Singh.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the other two co-accused namely Mukhtiar Singh and Gurdev Singh have been granted the concession of bail by this Court in CRM-M No.36645 of 2019 and CRM-M No.3194 of 2020 decided on 09.01.2020 and 13.02.2020 (Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively), who are similarly placed as the petitioner. He contends that the concession of bail be, therefore, granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State could not dispute the fact that the petitioner is similarly placed as the other co-accused Gurdev Singh and Mukhtiar Singh, who have been granted the concession of bail by this

Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner is granted the concession of bail and he be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.

Any observations made hereinabove are for the purpose of disposal of the present petition alone and shall have no bearing on the merit of the case during the trial in any manner.
