1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking a direction to be issued to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct an impartial and fair investigation against respondent No.4 on representation dated 21.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) and further to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her children at the hands of respondent No.4.

2. It is contended that the petitioner has submitted a representation to respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station, Khanora, Tehsil Nabha, District Patiala levelling allegations of fraud and threat to life and liberty of the petitioner and her children at the hands of respondent No.4.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Davinder Bir Singh, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the complaint of the petitioner. Let adequate number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him

during the course of day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 21.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
