Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the decision of this Court Annexure P-2 dated 19.07.2019 in CWP No.6812 of 2019, the claim made by the petitioner was decided in his favour vide order Annexure P-3 dated 06.12.2019 but fixation of pay and arrears in respect thereto has not been carried out in terms of order Annexure P-3 till date.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file an application to respondent No.4 for grant of benefits in terms of order Annexure P-3 dated 06.12.2019 and for issuance of directions to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive

representation for grant of benefits in terms of order Annexure P-3 within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case any such representation is submitted by the petitioner, respondent No.4 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner preferably within a period of three months thereafter.

4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to take out proceedings in accordance with law in respect of his grievance with regard to non-compliance of order of this Court dated 19.07.2019 in CWP No.6812 of 2019.
