1. Mr. Ankur Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from Mr. Uttam Dhalia, Deputy Director, Panchayat Development, states that the application filed by the Gram Panchayat, village Pirthala, District Fatehabad, ('Gram Panchayat') under Rule 12 (4) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Rules 1964, as applicable to State of Haryana, will be disposed of by the State Government within a period of one week from today and the order will be communicated to the Gram Panchayat within a week thereafter. Mr. Mittal states that till the order is communicated, no coercive steps will be taken against the Appellants.

2. It is directed that the said order shall not be given effect to for a further period of 10 days after it is communicated to the Appellants, to enable them to seek appropriate remedies against such order, if it is adverse to them, in accordance with law.

3. The application is accordingly disposed of.

4. In view of the above order in CM-1337-LPA-2020, it is agreed by learned Counsel for the parties that the main appeal itself can be disposed of.
