This is a petition that has been filed seeking quashing of the order dated 22.05.2019 passed by the JMIC, Hisar whereby the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed offenders in a complaint filed under Sections 304-B, 498-A, 323, 344, 34 IPC.

It is argued that the petitioners herein are daily wagers and the said notices were accepted on their behalf however, due intimation was never given to them. It is further argued that one opportunity be allowed to them to put in an appearance before the Court below as they are ready to face trial while further arguing that the criminal complaint was filed under the afore-said Sections after a gap of one year of the death of the daughter of the complainant, who incidentally died on account of bed-sores, which bed sores were on account of being bed ridden for a long time.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition *in limine* by staying the arrest of the petitioners for a period of two weeks to enable them to appear before the trial Court and move an appropriate application for having the impugned order set aside, which would be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law.
