Petitioner is aggrieved of the action of the respondent authorities in having declined his claim for promotion as TGT (Sanskrit) on the ground that he did not have Sanskrit as a teaching subject in B.Ed.

The categoric contention raised by counsel is that as per Haryana School Education (Group-C) State Cadre Service (Amendment) Rules 2017 petitioner possesses the requisite qualifications to be considered for promotion and the respondent authorities cannot insist upon a qualification/eligibility condition which is alien to the rules.

Counsel states that he would be satisfied if the writ petition were to be disposed of with a direction to the concerned authority to examine the claim of the petitioner.

Submission made by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without even opining on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant

writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e.the Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 22.12.2019 (Annexure P-7) and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
