The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.143 dated 11.05.2019, under Sections 447, 511, 506, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 02.01.2020. Admittedly, he is not the Vendee of the disputed property which was allegedly sold on the basis of a fictitious Power of Attorney in favour of his son. His further detention, at this stage, after completion of the investigation against him in the circumstances is not justified.

[3]. As such, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty

Magistrate, concerned.
