Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 12.02.2020 passed by the learned MACT/Executing Court Panchkula, whereby the petitioner-Insurance Company has been asked to make the payment of TDS already deposited with the Income Tax Department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-Insurance Company has pointed out that since the execution petition itself has been withdrawn by the claimants-decree holders, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed off.

Ordered accordingly.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available, in accordance with law, if the occasion so arises.
