The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

This is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.134 dated 05.10.2019 under Sections 316, 342, 365, 506, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC registered at Police Station Partap Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 14.10.2019. The Challan in the case has been presented and the matter has otherwise been compromised between the parties on 13.05.2020. He further submits that he has circulated the copy of compromise on *Whats App* group.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the custody of the applicant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 14.10.2019 coupled with the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, this Court finds that no useful purpose would be served while keeping the petitioner behind the bars, more particularly when the conclusion of trial is likely to take long time.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall decide the case without being influenced with these observations in any manner.
