[1]. Notice of motion.

[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

[3]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits *inter alia* that his client was originally on bail in the case pending before the Ld. Trial Court. He, however, could not appear on the date fixed i.e. 20.02.2020, on account of the fact that being a Taxi Driver, he had to go to Delhi Airport to drop some passenger, on that date. As such, his bail bonds were cancelled and warrants of arrest were ordered to be issued against him.

[4]. Submits further that the petitioner, henceforth, will ensure that he will not be absent during proceedings before the Trial Court in future.

[5]. In such circumstances, the present petition is disposed off, after setting aside the impugned order and with liberty to the petitioner to appear
