Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in CRA No.9 of 2018 in Complaint No.3243 dated 06.09.2013 under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 120-B, 34 IPC, titled as **Ajay Kumar Versus Manju Rani.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is on account of non-appearance of the petitioner on a single date i.e. on 17.02.2020 before the Appellate Authority, his bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State. He further states that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the Appellate Authority regularly to face the trial.

At this stage, without issuing notice to the respondents in the case and considering the single default for non-appearance on 17.02.2020, in case, the petitioner appears before the Appellate Authority within a period of ten days from today with a further undertaking that he will

continue to appear regularly before the Appellate Authority, the petitioner shall be admitted on bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
