JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.02 dated 19.02.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station NRI, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is submitted that the matter has been compromise between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating

Officer, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
