The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with FIR No.0002 dated 07.01.2020 on the file of Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural, registered under Sections 21 and 23 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985; Sections 411 and 414 IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on); and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 .

By order dated 06.03.2020 passed in this case, this Court directed the petitioner to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer. In such an event, the petitioner was also required to abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, would inform this Court, on the strength of the instructions given by ASI Charanjeet Singh, Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural, that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the aforestated order and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed directing the release of the petitioner in the event his arrest is warranted or required in FIR No.0002 dated 07.01.2020 on the file of Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural, upon his furnishing a personal bond along with two sureties to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer. In such an event, the petitioner shall also abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
