The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take legal action against the private respondents accused in FIR No.606 dated 22.07.2015 under Sections 278, 323, 506 and 509 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon.

Vide order dated 11.01.2017, this Court had directed the official respondents to conduct fresh investigation in the aforementioned FIR from some independent agency by not associating the police officials of P.S. Civil Lines, Gurgaon, as they were accused in FIR No.381 dated 29.07.2010.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rohtash Singh, has apprised this Court that after passing of the order dated 11.01.2017, the

police has conducted investigation and after completion of investigation, prepared a cancellation report in the case on 28.11.2018 and presented the same before the trial Court on 28.11.2018 itself.

In view of the fact that the police has prepared a cancellation report and presented the same to the trial Court, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner still feels aggrieved, he is at liberty to file protest petition before the concerned Court and the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law.
