Learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of arguments has contended that the cancellation report with regard to the FIR has since been filed in the trial Court, which is pending. The petitioner intends to go abroad and since the FIR against him is still in existence, he is unable to go.

Learned counsel further contends that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition but a direction be issued to the trial Court to dispose of the cancellation report expeditiously.

Permission to withdraw the petition is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court is directed to pass appropriate order on the cancellation report expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of order there and if need

be, the case be preponed.
