Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 15.10.2018 passed by the Chairman/Members of Child Welfare Committee (Bench of Magistrates), Karnal and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has raised an objection that as per Section 101 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the petitioner has an efficacious remedy of filing an appeal before the authorities.

In view of the above, learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition and prays that he may be granted 15 days time to file an appeal before the appellate authority and the appellate authority may be directed to decide the matter on merits.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.3 have no objection to the same.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is directed that in case the petitioner files an appeal before the appellate authority within a period of 15 days from today, the same be decided on merits without raising an objection regarding delay in filing the appeal.
