Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.136 dated 29.12.2018 under Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act and Sections 148, 149, 307, 324 IPC, registered at Police Station Bapoli, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 30.12.2018. He further submits that both material witnesses, namely, Amit-complainant and eyewitness Shamsheer Singh have been examined as PW4 and PW5 respectively.

Learned State counsel, on instructions SI Suresh Kumar, opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner and filed custody certificate dated 06.11.2019, which is taken on record.

I have considered the rival submissions.

The petitioner is behind the bars for the last more than one year and one month. The trial of the case will take some more time and further

detention of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat.
