Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take action against private respondents, who are harassing the school management and are agitating against the working of the school, which is effecting the rights of the children.

On 9.5.2018, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda was directed to ensure that the working of the school is not obstructed and no inconvenience is caused to the students and the staff of the school due to any illegal activity of private respondents.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Talwandi Sabo is on the record and as per the same, respondent No.6 to 10 were terminated by the petitioner-management and on that account, they started agitating against the Managing Committee. It is further submitted that during the enquiry, it is found that the private respondents were staging in Dharna outside the school and Ranjit Singh, Manager of the petitioner-

School has made a statement before the Enquiry Officer that the private respondents No.6 to 10 have lifted the Dharna on 5.5.2018 and have not staged any Dharna/agitation subsequently. It is further stated that in case the respondents No.6 to 10 indulge into any such type of illegal activity against the petitioner, the local administration, i.e. the police and Sub Divisional Magistrate will proceed, in accordance with law.

In view of the same, the present petition is rendered infructuous and the same stands disposed of as such.
