Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the official respondents No.2 to 4 for taking appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 to 14 for torturing and harassing the petitioner on account of insufficient dowry and treating her with cruelty, as she could not conceive a child and was turned out from her matrimonial home. A further prayer has also been made for issuing directions to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the complaints/representations dated 23.10.2019 and 24.02.2020 (appended as Annexures P-1 & P-2, respectively).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to look into the complaints/representations dated 23.10.2019 and 24.02.2020 (Annexures P-1 & P-2) and take appropriate action.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3 - Assistant Commissioner of Police, Crime Against Women, Jalandhar, to look into the complaints/representations dated 23.10.2019 and 24.02.2020 (Annexures P-1 & P-2) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
