For the reasons stated in the application, the same is
allowed and the main case is taken up today for hearing.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the
petitioner in FIR No.105 dated 08.02.2020 registered under Section
174-A IPC at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the FIR under
Section 174-A IPC was registered as the petitioner could not appear
before the trial Court. It is further submitted that on coming to know
about this fact, the petitioner has already compromised the case with the

complainant registered under the Negotiable Instruments Act and therefore, no purpose will be served for directing the petitioner to face the prosecution under Section 174-A IPC. Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the medical record of the petitioner to submit that he is not maintaining good health.

Considering the fact that the complaint under the Negotiable Instruments Act already stands withdrawn on the basis of the compromise, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days to join investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
- 3. He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.*
