Prayer in the application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for withdrawal of the petition, which is otherwise fixed for hearing on 27.02.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of present petition, the matter has amicably been settled between the parties and accordingly, the petitioner wish to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to file fresh one so as to seek quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

At this stage, Mr. Vikram Singh Kang, Advocate, for Mr. Preetinder Singh Ahluwalia, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed his *vakalatnama*, which is taken on record. He states that he has no instructions as regards the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of above, the application is allowed and the hearing of the petition is preponed and the same is taken on board today itself.

Since the prayer of the petitioner is for withdrawal of present petition, however, with liberty to file fresh one, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, with liberty to file fresh one so as to seek quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise if so arrived at between the parties.

CRM-M-19608-2018 stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
