The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.183 dated 22.11.2019, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been in custody since the date of registration of the FIR. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as examination of PWs has not yet commenced. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner and thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel concedes the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner and that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
