Challenge in this writ petition is to the order dated 2.3.2020
(Annexure P-4) passed by the Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies,
Sangrur, placing the petitioner under suspension from service.

While So, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, learned Assistant Advocate
General, Punjab, appearing for the respondent-authorities filed his short
reply by way of an affidavit, along with a copy of order dated 19.3.2020
passed by the Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, Sangrur. By the
said order, the Assistant Registrar withdrew the earlier suspension order
dated 2.3.2020 passed by him with immediate effect.

In the light of this development, the cause in this writ petition
no longer survives for consideration on merits. The writ petition is
accordingly dismissed.

It is made clear that this Court has not gone into the merits of
this matter and this order will not preclude the competent authority from

taking appropriate action against the petitioner, if warranted, in accordance with the due procedure.
