This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation dated 21.02.2020 to respondents No.2 and 3— Director General of Police, Punjab at Chandigarh and Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 and 3—Director General of Police, Punjab at Chandigarh and Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala, to look into and decide representation dated 21.02.2020 (Annexure P/3) as expeditiously as possible and that too in accordance with law.
