Petitioner is a JBT Teacher currently posted at Government Primary School, Kotli, Block Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Instant writ petition has been filed seeking an inter District transfer in terms of preferences furnished by the petitioner as per an inter District Transfer Policy dated 06.08.2015 (Annexure P-1) issued by the State Government.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard and pleadings on record have been perused.

Concededly, the post of JBT is a district cadre post. Matter with regard to an inter District transfer would be solely within the domain of the employer. Even if the Inter District Transfer Policy has been framed by the State Government, the terms and conditions contained therein would not vest an enforceable right with the petitioner. No mandamus in such regard, as such, can be issued.

Writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the

petitioner to pursue his claim with the appropriate State authority.
