This is a petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide adequate security and protection to the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.

Learned counsel for petitioner contended that petitioners have already made representations dated 06.10.2017, 27.12.2017, 09.02.2018 and 08.11.2019 to respondent No.2—Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, copies of which are available on the file as Annexure P/1 (Colly), but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Ms. Ashima Mor, APP, U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to her.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2—Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh, to look into and decide representations dated 06.10.2017, 27.12.2017, 09.02.2018 and 08.11.2019 (Annexure P/1-Colly) within eight weeks positively and that too in accordance with law.
