2. This Court finds no illegality or impropriety in the impugned order passed by the Ld. Trial Court, since it has been done in valid exercise of the Powers conferred upon it after insertion of Section 143-A of the Negotiable Instruments Act in the year 2018, in a situation where the disputed cheque itself was drawn up and dishonoured in the year 2019.

3. In such circumstances, the present petition is, therefore, dismissed. However, in the interest of justice, the petitioner is granted time to make the deposit as directed by the Ld. Trial Court within a period of 30 days from today, during which period, no recovery proceedings against him shall be commenced.
