Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have since joined the investigation and have been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajiv Kumar concedes this fact, further stating that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

The dispute is stated to have been resolved amicably between the parties. Learned counsel appearing for the complainant in the connected matter admits the factum of compromise. Under these circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 13.03.2020 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.That the petitioners shall make themselves available for investigation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2.That they shall not directly or indirectly make any

- inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
- 3.That they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
- 4.They shall surrender their passports before the Investigating Officer and if they are not having passports, then, shall file the affidavits in that regard.

In case, the petitioners violate any terms & conditions, on which the bail has been granted to them, the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
