GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Kehar Singh, stated to be aged 55 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ or direction for setting aside the order dated 05.03.2020 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Election Tribunal, Tarn Taran, whereby, order of recounting of votes has been made for the post of Sarpanch Village Naushehra, Block Gandiwind, Tehsil and District Tarn Taran.

Records of the case show that on 18.03.2020, notice of motion was issued. Thereafter, on 20.03.2020, the matter was adjourned to 16.04.2020 and interim directions were given.

Today, on resumed hearing of the case, both learned counsel make

a joint statement that the present petition can be disposed of by technically quashing the order dated 05.03.2020 with further directions to the Election Tribunal to decide the case by framing appropriate issues and taking evidence in accordance with law within a period of four months.

In view of the above peculiar facts and circumstances, order dated 05.03.2020 is quashed with a direction to the Election Tribunal to decide the case of the petitioner by framing issues and taking evidence in accordance with law, within a period of four months.

Civil Revision petition is disposed of accordingly.
