1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.135 dated 27.07.2012, registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.
3. Learned Counsel contends that vide order dated 06.05.2020, the petitioner was directed to appear before the Investigating Officer, as and when required and definitely within 01 week of 17.05.2020 and to fully co-operate with the investigation of the case and in the event of his arrest, petitioner was ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail

the conditions envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI, Bhag Singh, states that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 06.05.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail on his furnishing bail bonds and that his custodial interrogation is not required in the case.

5. In view of the position as noted above, order dated 06.05.2020, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the petitioner complying with the conditions envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
