Aashik, accused of FIR No. 463 dated 24.7.2018 registered at Police Station, Mujesar, District Faridabad under Sections 380 and 457 of the Indian Penal Code prays for grant of regular bail.

Heard.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Haryana.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, appears on behalf of the State of Haryana.

Counsel for the petitioner would argue that the petitioner has been indicted in the crime on the statement of co-accused namely Asruddin @ Asru @ Bhondu. It is further argued that no recovery in respect of the alleged theft of Rs. 15,88,900/- from ATM was effected from the petitioner. The last submission made by counsel is that the petitioner is willing to face trial without any default.

Counsel representing the State of Haryana has contested the application with the submission that another criminal case has been

registered against the petitioner under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 within the jurisdiction of Delhi.

The accused is in custody since 6.12.2019. Challan has been presented in the Court and conclusion of trial will take its own time. There is no allegation against the petitioner that he is likely to flee from process of justice in case enlarged on bail.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the controversy, bail to the petitioner subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad. However, he shall abide by the following conditions:-

(i)He shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and

(ii)He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
