[1] Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer at par with his juniors who are likely to be promoted to the post of Superintending Engineer.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P/13) dated 10.04.2019 in respect of the claim, which is the subject matter of the writ petition and that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P/13) dated 10.04.2019, in accordance with law.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only.

[4] Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1, waives service and

states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

[5] Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim made in the representation (Annexure P/13) dated 10.04.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.
