Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 5 states that in case the petitioner deposit an amount of ₹93,830/- on account of shortage of transformer oil and missing parts, the petitioner will be issued no objection certificate and shall also be considered for appointment against the vacant post which has been reserved by respondent No.5.

2. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the stand of learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4, the petitioner would deposit a sum of ₹93,830/- within ten days from today and the writ petition may be disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to issue no objection certificate and further by directing respondent No.3 to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Grid Sub-Station Operator against the post kept vacant by respondent No.5.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to deposit a sum of ₹93,830/- within ten days from today. In case, the amount referred to above is deposited by the petitioner within stipulated period of time, needful be done by the respondents within four weeks thereafter.
