Learned counsel for the petitioners, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to first approach the respondents with the grievance, as has been highlighted by them in the present writ petition with reference to the Punjab Government Circular dated 30.08.1996 (Annexure P-8), wherein the situation, as in the present case, has been dealt with under which the petitioners assert that they would be entitled to the relief.

Let the said representation be made within a period of four weeks to the Secretary, Department of Revenue, Rehabilitation and Disaster Management, Punjab and Director, Land Records, Jalandhar-respondents No.1 and 2 respectively.

On doing so, let a decision thereon be taken by the said respondents within a period of six weeks of such submission of the representation.

The said decision be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

The writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with above observations.
