All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition filed under the provisions of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent authorities to pay the arrears of salary to the petitioner as per the revised pay scales as recommended by the UGC to the equivalent cadres in Universities and Colleges, following revision of pay-scales of the Central Government employees on the recommendation of the 7th Pay Commission.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is stated to have got a legal notice issued, dated 09.07.2019 (copy Annexure P-6), which has still not been decided by the respondents (as contended).

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, also taking into consideration the representation of the

petitioner (copy Annexure P-5), by passing a detailed speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If a completely detailed speaking order has already been passed by the competent authority, then only a short order would now be needed to be passed, annexing therewith the detailed order already passed (if any).
