1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0010 dated 19.03.2019, registered under Sections 379, 411, 420 and 472 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 17.03.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
