Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for grievance which has been made by the petitioners and the claims put forth by them in the present writ petition, they have served a notice dated 18.12.2019 (Annexure P-8) upon respondents No.1 and 2. Counsel further states that the petitioners would serve a fresh notice upon the respondents within a period of one week, which may be ordered to be considered and decided at an early date.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the merit or going into the facts and circumstances of the case, the present writ petition is disposed with liberty to the petitioners to serve a fresh notice upon the respondents within a period of one week from today. If such a notice is served, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents and decision taken thereon within a period of twelve weeks from the date of serving of such notice. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.
