ARCHANA PURI, J.

The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari and mandamus for quashing the transfer order dated 11.03.2020 passed by respondent No.2, transferring the petitioner from GITI (Women) Jind to GITI Sirsa.

At this stage, learned State counsel does not want to file reply but however, he has brought to the notice of this Court that present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has voluntarily sought transfer and he has joined at GITI, Piyau Majra, Hisar. This fact has also not been disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the petitioner having sought online transfer and

having joined new station of posting, the present petition, as such, has become infructuous as the present petition has been filed challenging the transfer order dated 11.03.2020, which no longer subsist qua the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
