SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.24, dated 18.01.2018, registered under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Model Town, District Ludhiana.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete set of paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

4. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits *inter alia* that the petitioner was earlier on bail. However, he could not appear in Court on one solitary date, i.e., 04.03.2020, on account of wrong noting of date and due to his absence, his bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrant was issued against him.

5. After hearing both sides, the matter is disposed off with a liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a week from today and seek a fresh bail. In the meantime, warrant of arrest issued against him shall remain stayed.
