The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 31 dated 03.02.2020, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

The operative part of the order dated 02.06.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the present case, since the petitioner is not directly involved in the offences as per the complaint and his name has cropped up subsequently, let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, on 05.06.2020 at 10 A.M., to join investigation.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 02.06.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from

the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 02.06.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
