The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.73 dated 20.02.2020 under Section 14 of Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986 and Sections 75 & 79 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

The operative part of the order dated 17.03.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that to show his bonafide, the petitioner is ready to pay a sum of Rs.25,000/- each to both the children namely Brijesh Pandey and Ritesh Pandey, without prejudice to his right of defence to be taken during the course of trial.

Notice of motion for 11.05.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 17.03.2020, has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that the petitioner has deposited a sum of Rs. 50,000/- in compliance with the order dated 17.03.2020.

Learned State counsel, on telephonic instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid facts.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 17.03.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
