Prayer in this application is for impleading legal representative(s) (in short “LRs”) of Banta Singh-appellant.

In view of averments made in the application supported by an affidavit of Daljit Singh son of Banta Singh and arguments advanced, application is allowed and persons mentioned in para 4 of the application are allowed to be brought on record as LR's of Banta Singh-appellant (since deceased), subject to just exceptions, for the purpose of present lis only.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Disposed of accordingly.

Main Cases

This order will dispose of FAO Nos.580 to 582 of 1996 as identical questions of law and fact are involved for adjudication. For facility of reference, facts are taken from FAO No.580 of 1996.

Counsel for the appellant would argue that controversy raised in

the appeal is squarely covered by judgment of this Court **Jatinder Bachan Singh Grewal Vs. Union of India and anr., FAO No.3978 of 2004, decided on 06.08.2018** reference whereof has been made while deciding FAO No.5770 of 2004 on 17.12.2018 titled 'Dalip Kaur Vs. Union of India and anr.'

Counsel for the respondent-UIO concedes to, what has been stated by counsel for the appellant.

In view of the above, the aforesaid appeals stand disposed of, in terms of order dated 06.08.2018 passed by this Court in **Jatinder Bachan Singh Grewal's case (supra)**. The LR's of deceased appellant(s) would be at liberty to file appropriate application(s) before the executing Court for their impleadment and the same shall be decided, in accordance with law.
