Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to avail all other alternative efficacious remedies as may be available to him including moving an application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. before the court concerned in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

As regards the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that he apprehends threat to life and liberty, it shall be open to the petitioner to move an appropriate application to the police station concerned which shall be duly examined and in case it is found that there is any threat perception to the life and liberty, then necessary steps as warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.
