Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since the parties have amicably resolved their issues, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to apply for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid request, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 4 days from filing of such application while

keeping in view the assertion of the petitioner that the matter has been amicably resolved.
